We are proud to report that in 2018 the Autism Society of Southeastern Wisconsin:

- Provided over 3,390 help/support contacts. Over 490 hours were spent in providing information, resources, connecting people and being there to listen when needed.
- Offered 28 unique programs for children, teens, young adults, families and adults that enrich their lives equaling a total of 84 events that were brought to Southeastern Wisconsin in 2018.
- Offered five unique in-person support groups who met 65 times in 2018 for help, support and understanding.
- Reached over 1,000 individuals through our Facebook groups with around-the-clock connections & answers when people need it most.
- Provided 235 "New to Autism Kits" to individuals requesting information & resources who have just received a diagnosis for themselves or a loved one & need to know what to do next.
- Have provided 16 Safe & Sound training sessions & reached over 560 first-responders including police officers, EMTs & firefighters.
- Organized ten autism training & education sessions in the community specifically for educators & child care providers.
